In *myCampus*, each degree program is divided into three areas. It consists either of a major and a minor, or, in the teacher education program, of two teaching subjects or one teaching subject and the vocational specialization, as well as an overarching area. All three areas contain modules and exams for which you have to register.

After logging in to *myCampus*, click on the application “Exam Dates”. Click on “All Exams” in the top of the left corner. Use the filter to find the exam you want to register for.

Then click on the drop-down menu “Choose sub-programme”. You will be offered three options:

- Your major (1) or first teaching subject, labeled with the intended degree and the name of the major (MJ) or the first teaching subject or vocational specialization (teaching degree)
- Your minor (2) or second teaching subject, labeled with the degree objective and the name of your minor (MI) or the name of the second teaching subject
- Your overall degree program (3), titled with the names of your major and minor or the two teaching subjects



To register for an exam in a major (MJ) (1) or minor (MI) (2) or teaching subject, select the MJ or MI or teaching subject from the drop-down menu **“Choose sub-programme”**.

Please select the higher-level area (3) only for registering for examinations in the *Leuphana semester*, in the *complementary studies* or in the *professionalization area in the teaching profession* or *for real additional services*, which do not count for your curriculum.
